PREVENT WILDFIRES

THIS IS A SYNOPSIS

IT IS UNLAWFUL TO

- Burn any material other than CLEAN, UNTREATED WOOD which is NO GREATER THAN 5 INCHES IN DIAMETER.
- Burn when the ground is not covered by snow without a written NH FIRE
 PERMIT obtained from the Forest Fire Warden or online.
- Burn when RAINING without a written NH FIRE PERMIT obtained from the Forest Fire Warden or online.
- Burn in violation of DES Air Resource regulations.
- Burn between 9:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M., except for permitted Category I fires.
- Kindle a fire for any purpose on land of another without written permission of the owner or owner's agent and a written NH FIRE PERMIT obtained from the Forest Fire Warden or online, except in authorized recreational areas where suitable fireplaces are approved by the Forest Fire Warden.
- Fail to TOTALLY EXTINGUISH any fire before leaving it.
- Discard LIGHTED matches, cigarettes or other burning substances from vehicles or otherwise or throw any flammable waste material on, near or adjacent to a public highway or private way in or near woodlands.
- Fail to report a Wildfire or Brush Fire or fail to respond to a FOREST FIRE WARDEN'S call for assistance.

Violations of RSA 227-L are subject to the following penalties:

Violation – May be fined up to \$1,000
Misdemeanor – May be fined up to \$2,000
or imprisoned up to one year or both.
